

The temple's great cycad tree is 1,100 years old. The temple has the only Karesansui-style garden with a cycad in Japan.

November 11 (Sat.): Enjoy the temple lit up at night.

Get a close look at authentic paintings on fusuma sliding doors and walls, which were done around 400 years ago. Nearest station: Goryomae Station on the Hankai Electric

Nanshuji Temple

Famous as the temple where grand tea master Sen no Rikyu practiced the tea ceremony.

Nearest station: Goryomae Station on the Hankai Electric

Free Exhibitions



The most popular autumn festival in Sakai, which is to pray for a bountiful harvest, is held at this shrine.

Nearest station: Mozu Station on the JR Hanwa Line or Mozuhachiman Station on the Nankai



This is one of the most famous shrines in Sakai with a history of over 1,000 years.

Tea will be served during the opening period (fee applies).

One of the oldest private houses in Osaka, it is still used as a residence.

Open only on November 5 (Sun.).
