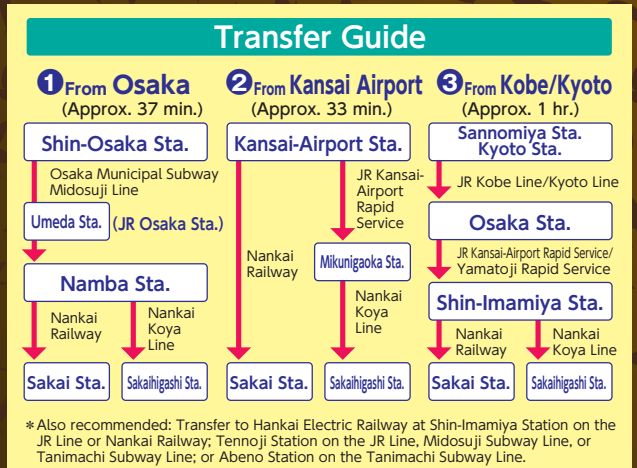
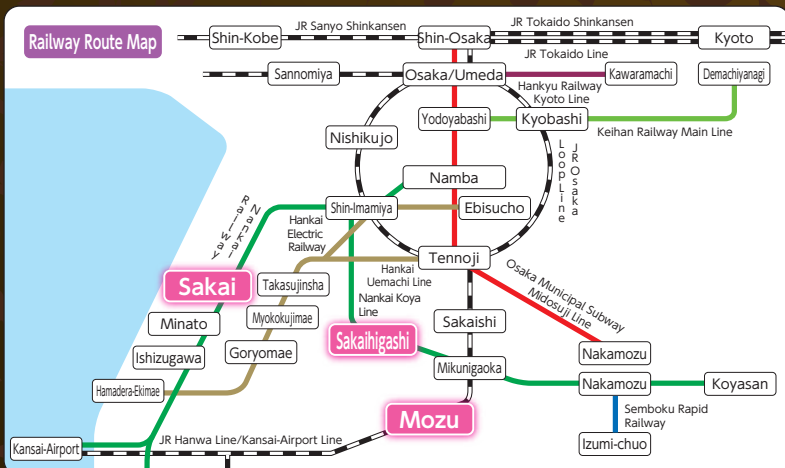
## Special Exhibition of Cultural Properties in Sakai

## Paid Exhibitions



Myokokuji Temple

The temple's great cypress tree is 1,100 years old. The temple has the only Karesansui-style garden with a cypress in Japan.

- November 11 (Sat.): Enjoy the temple lit up at night.
- November 12 (Sun.): A concert will be held (entry fee applies).

Nearest station: Myokokuji Station on the Hankai Electric Railway



Daianji Temple

Get a close look at authentic paintings on fusuma sliding doors and walls, which were done around 400 years ago.

Nearest station: Goryomae Station on the Hankai Electric Railway



Nanshuji Temple

Famous as the temple where grand tea master Sen no Rikyu practiced the tea ceremony.

Nearest station: Goryomae Station on the Hankai Electric Railway

**\* Fee for paid exhibitions: 400 yen per site.**

**\* Discounted ticket book available.**

A book of three tickets can be bought for 1,000 yen during the exhibition period. Available at Information Centers in the city (Sakai Station Tourist Information Center and Daisen Park Tourist Information Center), paid exhibition sites, etc.



## Free Exhibitions



Mozu-Hachimangu Shrine

The most popular autumn festival in Sakai, which is to pray for a bountiful harvest, is held at this shrine.

Nearest station: Mozu Station on the JR Hanwa Line or Mozuhachiman Station on the Nankai Railway Koya Line



Takabayashi Residence

One of the oldest private houses in Osaka, it is still used as a residence.

- Open only on November 5 (Sun.).

Nearest station: Mozu Station on the JR Hanwa Line



Aguchi Shrine

This is one of the most famous shrines in Sakai with a history of over 1,000 years.

- Tea will be served during the opening period (fee applies).
- November 3 (Fri.): A free concert will be held.

Nearest station: Shukuin Station on the Hankai Electric Railway



Old Gunsmith's House

This building is approximately 400 years old and it still retains some aspects of being a gunsmith's workshop.

- It will only be open on November 3 (Fri.).

Nearest station: Takasujinsha Station on the Hankai Electric Railway
